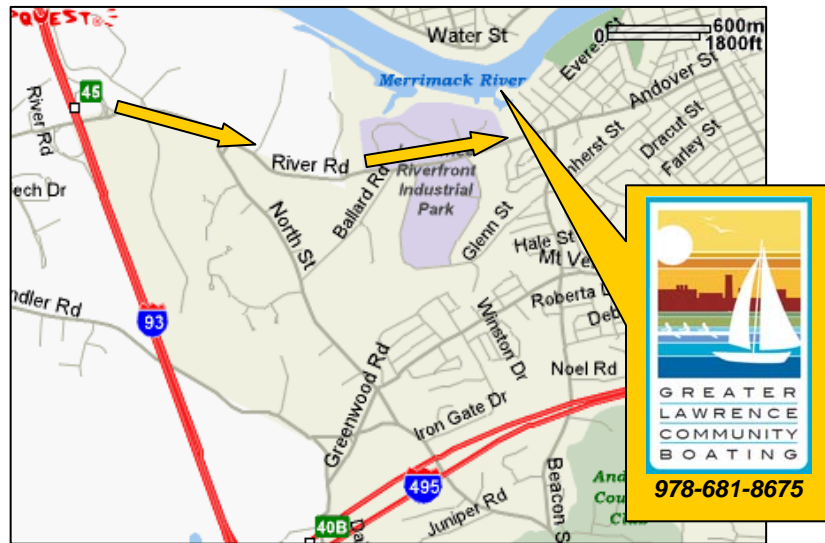


Greater Lawrence Community Boating

Rowing is a lifelong sport that teaches teamwork and challenges each individual to excel. Our coaching staff is well trained to help you reach your highest aspirations in competition, general fitness, and general enjoyment on the water.

YOUTH

Junior Team: Open to all area high school students. Focus is on teamwork and mastery of the sport and preparation for local and regional competition. Assistance with college recruiting is also available. Cost: \$300 per season.

- Spring Season: March 16-May 29. Practice is M-F from 3:30-5:30 pm.
- Summer Season: July 6-Aug. 24. Practice times TBA.
- Summer Crew League: Recreational teams learn the basics and participate in intramural competition. Geared toward beginners with little or no rowing experience. Check back for details

Middle School: Open to area youth in 7-8th grade. Focus is on skill development and enjoyment.

- April Vacation Learn to Row camp: April 21-23, 9:00-11:30am
Cost: \$80
- Spring Season: April 28-May 29, Tuesdays and Fridays, 4-5:30. Focus is on learning the fundamentals and enjoying the sport. Cost is \$125.
